Walker Wood Family Land Donation

The Walker Wood family made a historic contribution to our community this fall, gifting Halton Healthcare an unprecedented 105 acres of land valued at approximately \$45 million. This incredibly generous donation, the largest in the history of Halton Healthcare, paves the way for the redevelopment of Georgetown Hospital and additional healthcare facilities.

The Walker Wood family donated the farm that was their home for many years to Halton Healthcare in memory of Neil Cameron Walker Wood, who passed away in 2021. "My husband, Neil, and I have made the Walker Wood Farm in Georgetown our home for over 40 years," says Susan, Neil Walker Wood's wife. "The farm has been the centre of our family during that time, a beautiful space where we have created many wonderful memories. We have always held a strong belief in giving back to our community and it provides our family immense pleasure to donate this land in memory of my late husband. We are delighted that Halton Healthcare will honour my husband's legacy to advance healthcare for the people in this community for years to come."

The President & CEO of Halton Healthcare, Melissa Farrell, says the Wood family has strong ties to Georgetown and they are committed to advancing healthcare in the community. "The family is asking for very little in return for this staggeringly generous gift. They have asked that the land be used only for the purpose of enriching healthcare and wellness in the community, and that is exactly what we intend to do."

The need for healthcare services in this community is urgent and projected to continue growing. Georgetown Hospital was built in 1961 to meet the health needs of 10,000 residents. In 2021, the population in Halton Hills was almost 63,000 and the hospital also cares for many people from neighbouring municipalities such as Brampton, Caledon, Erin and Milton.

"There is a need to significantly expand and improve healthcare capacity and infrastructure to better serve our community," shared Melissa Farrell at an official announcement of the donation on November 3. "Now that Halton Healthcare has the land, we can get down to the detailed planning for a new hospital. We are actively engaged with the Ministry of Health to work through the many stages required for hospital capital planning, and having the land is an important step in securing approval for the next stage of redevelopment."

"Words cannot express our gratitude to the Walker Wood family for their transformative gift of 105 acres of land," says Georgetown Hospital Foundation Executive Director, Sandra Taylor. "We will look for ways to honour the memory of Neil Walker Wood and the generosity of his family. As we move forward, we will engage with the community to help redefine the future of Georgetown Hospital to better serve our community. We have always relied on you – our donors – and we will need your continued support as redevelopment forges ahead."


Brain Function Monitor – The funds raised during Smile Cookie week in May allowed the purchase of a brain function monitor for our Surgical Department. This is a brand new piece of equipment for Georgetown Hospital, and will be incredibly valuable to our surgical team.

Time Matters Campaign

The Georgetown Hospital Foundation is thrilled to be closing in on the \$500,000 *Time Matters* campaign goal for new and upgraded laboratory equipment, to ensure our healthcare teams have the fastest, most advanced and accurate lab results to diagnose and treat patients. In less than three years, the volume of tests being conducted in our lab has increased by nearly 30%. As our community continues to grow, so do we.

The *Time Matters* campaign is raising half a million dollars for four new essential pieces of laboratory equipment, including a Hematology Analyzer, CellaVision, a Coagulation Analyzer, and a new water filtration system. The addition of these important pieces of equipment will allow for increased capacity and reduce the turnaround time for test results. Because when it comes to your health, *time matters*.
